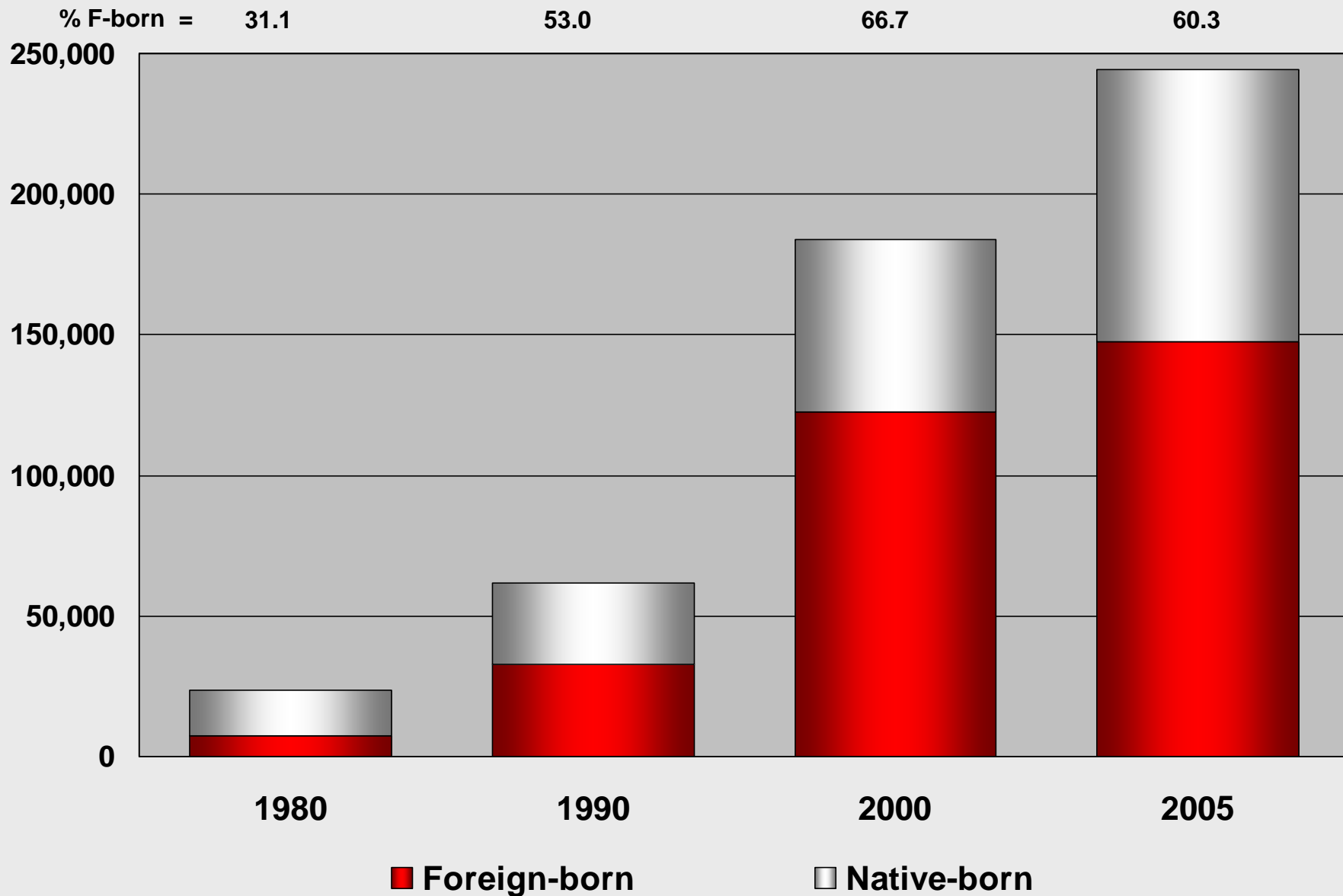

Mexicans by Nativity New York City, 1980-2005

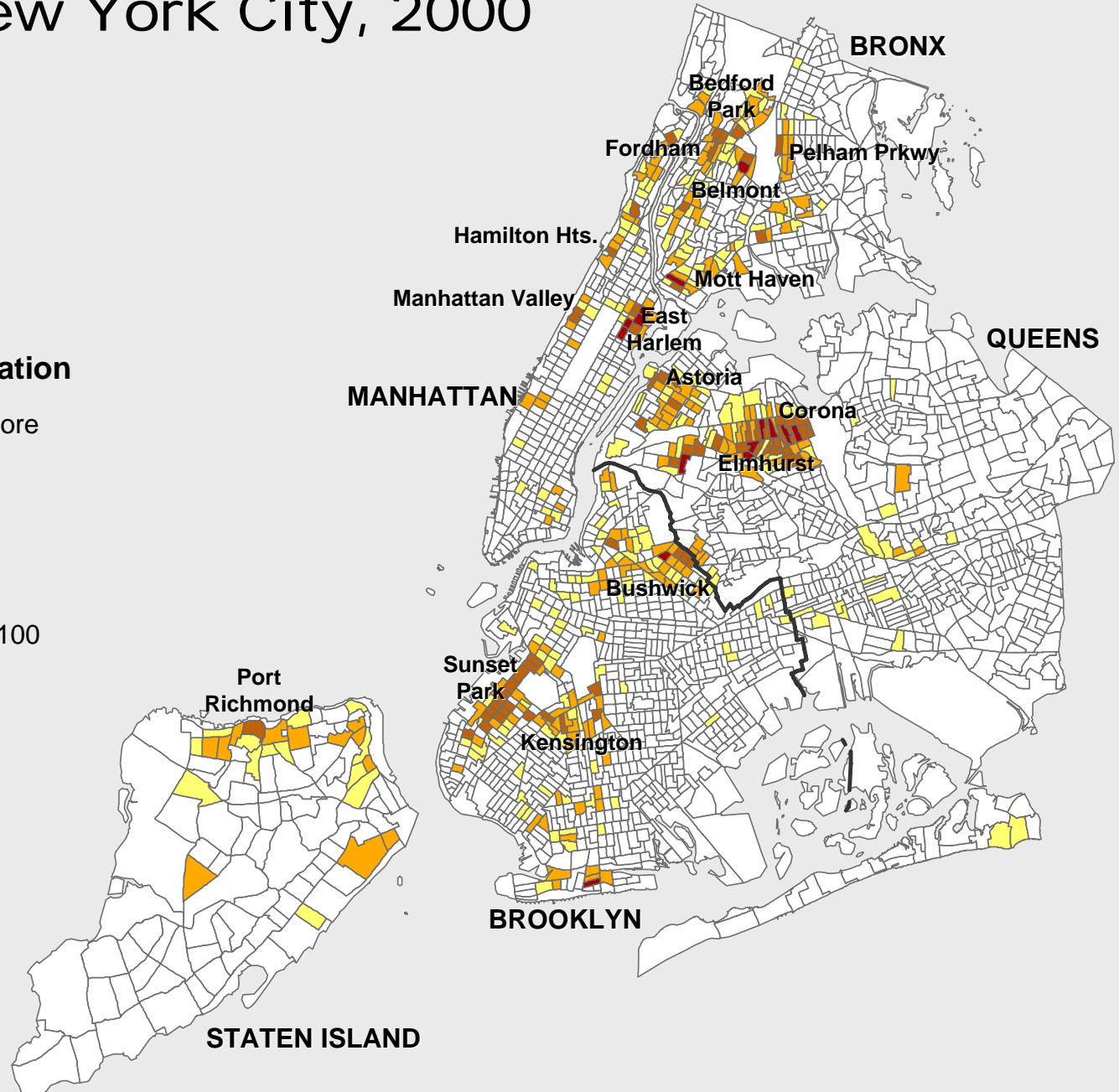
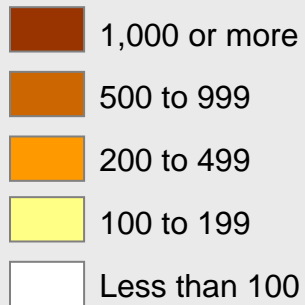


Foreign-born Population by Country of Birth New York City, 1990 and 2005

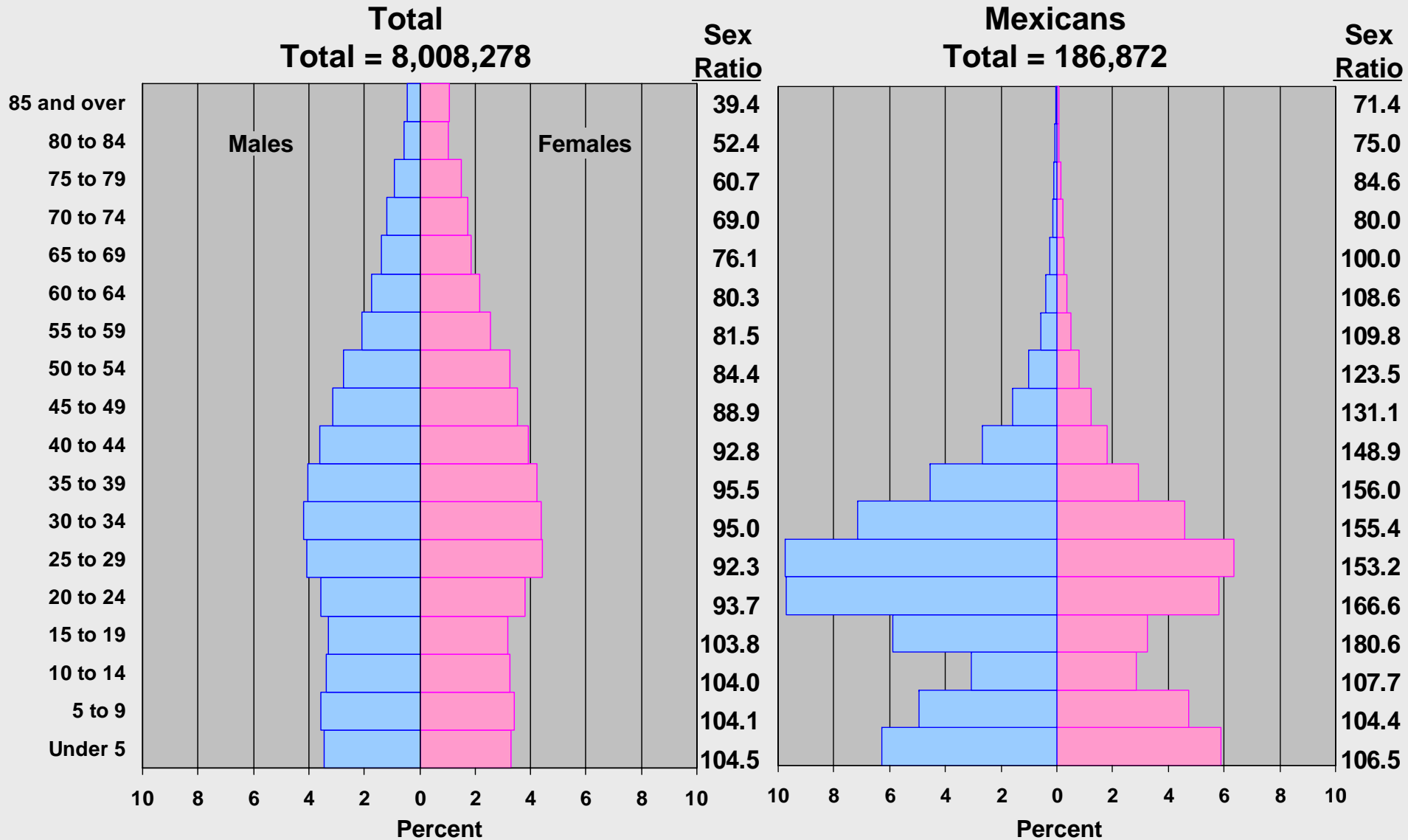

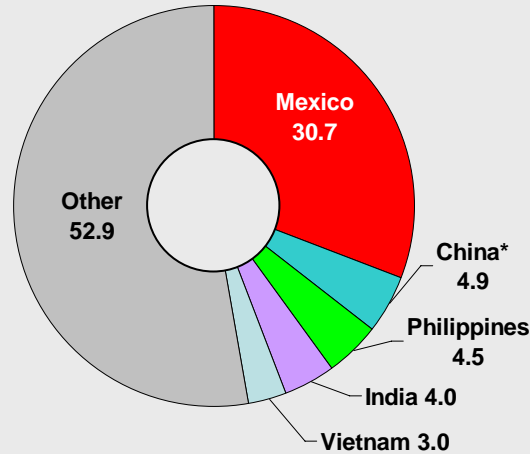

Percent Distribution of the Foreign-born U.S. and Top 4 U.S. Cities, 2005

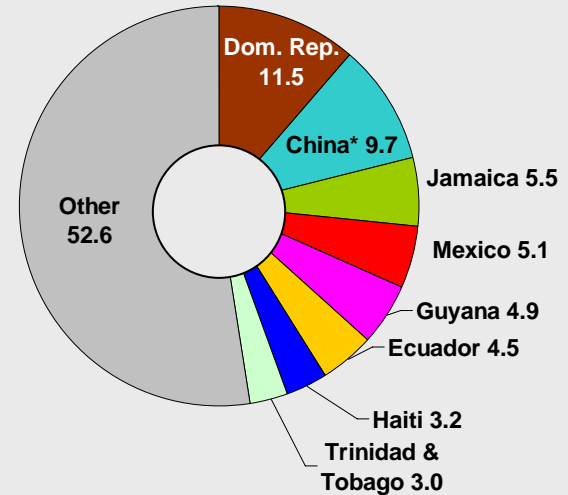

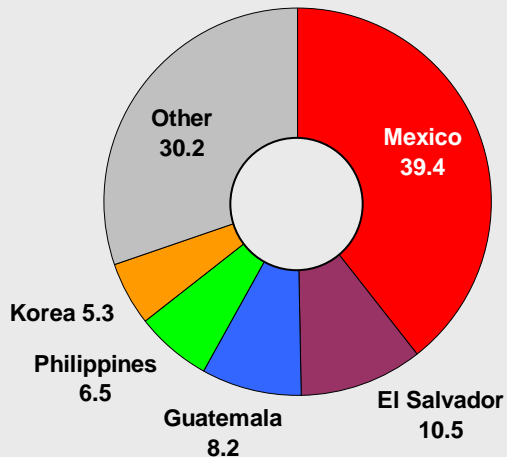

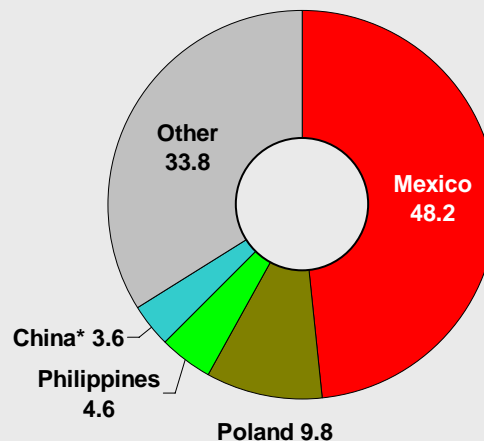

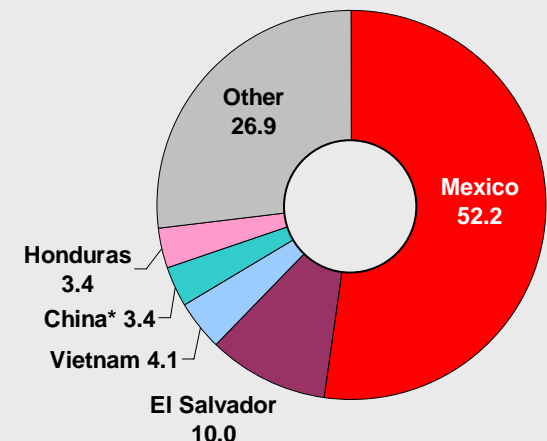

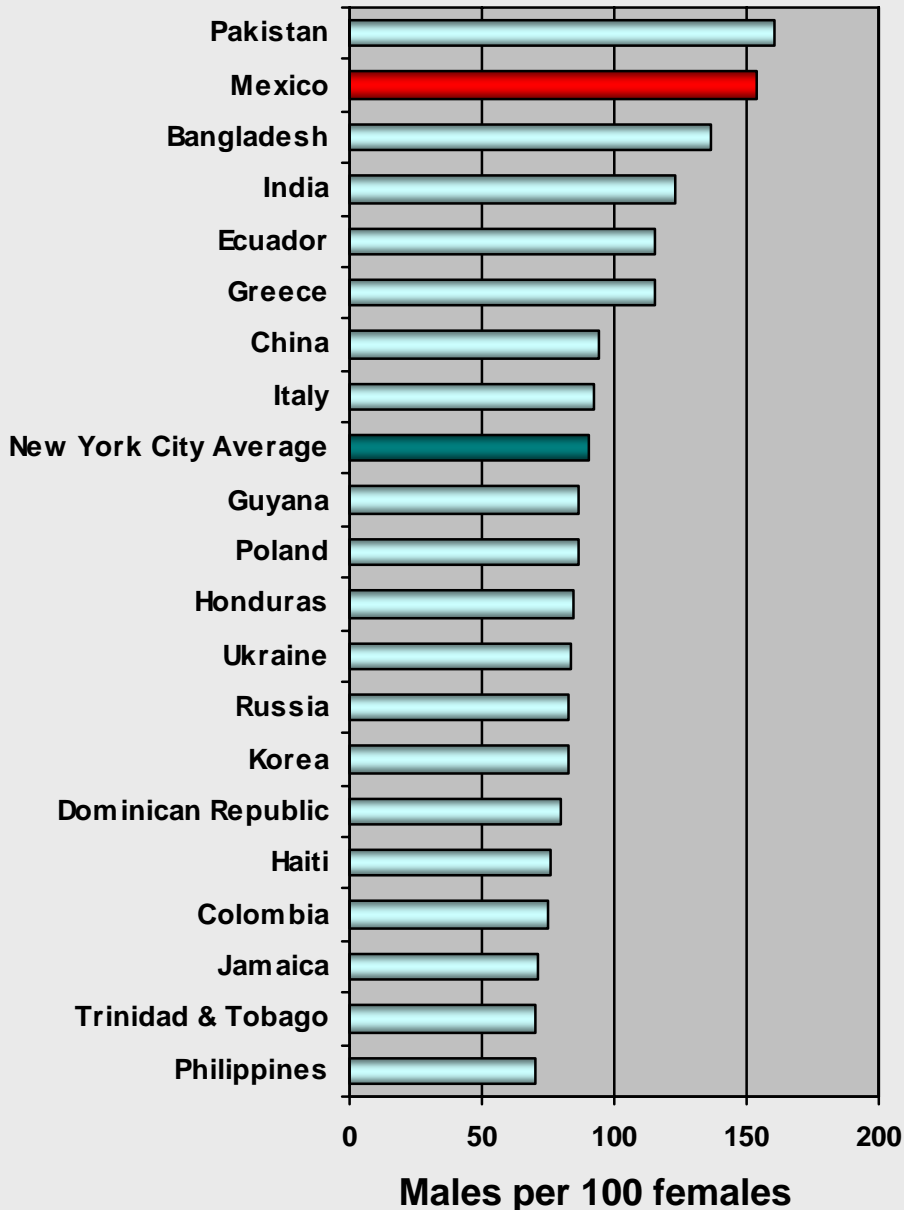

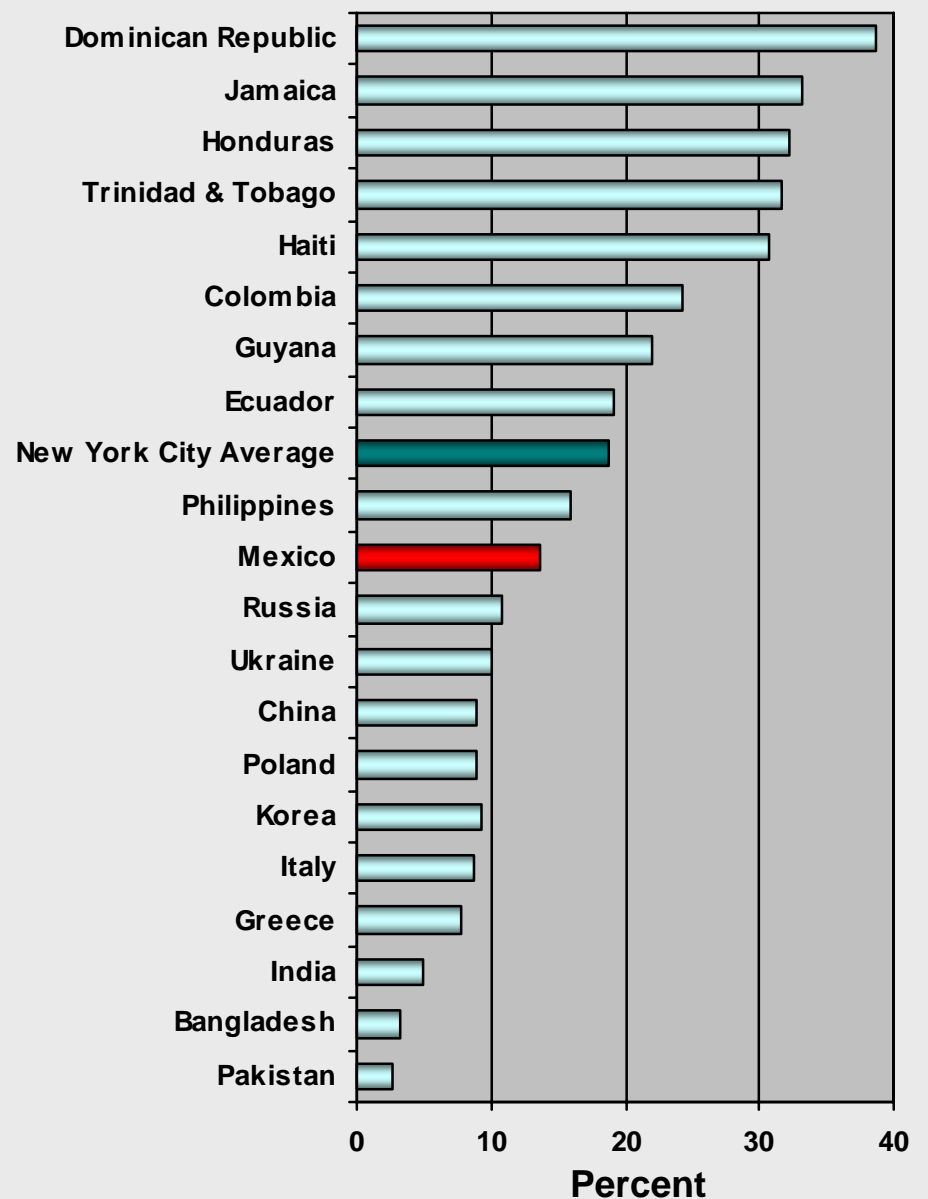

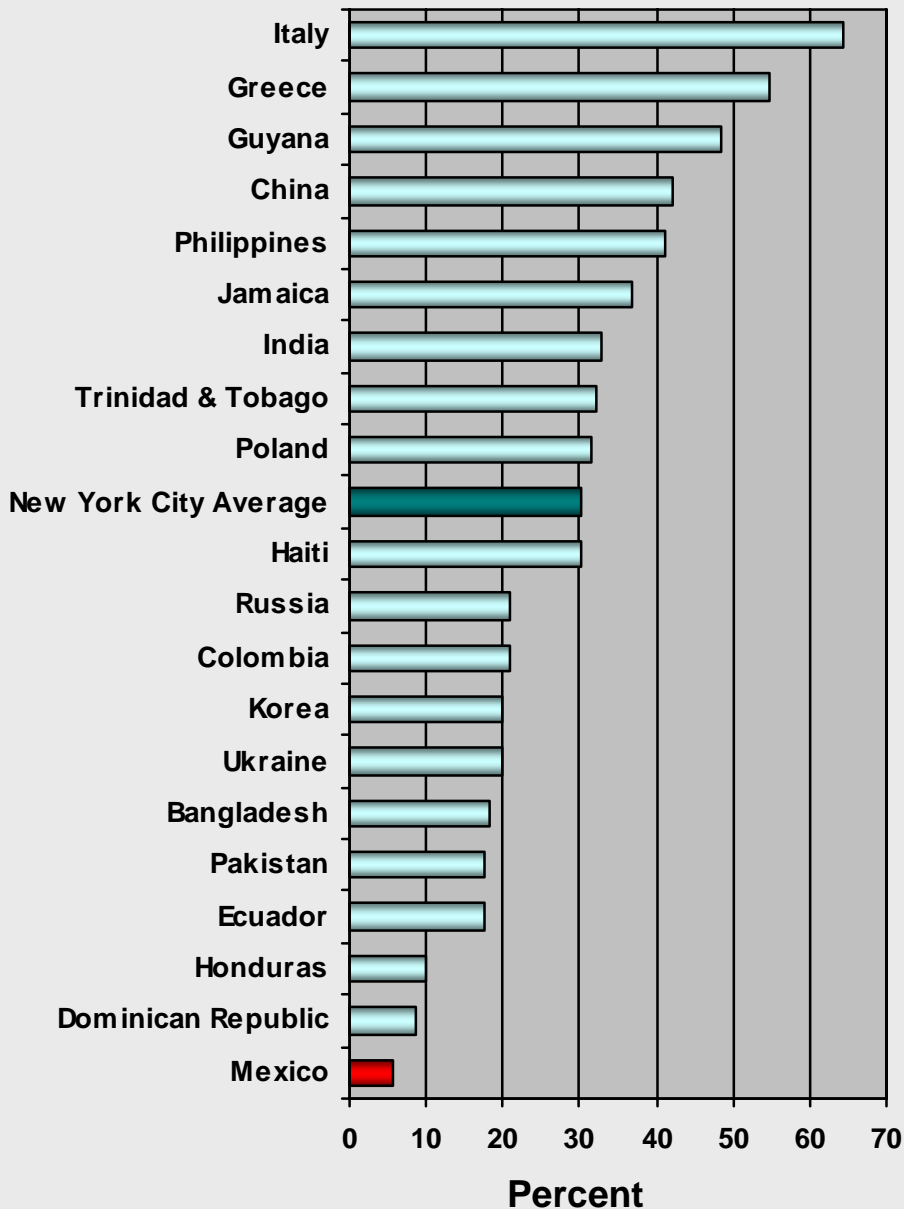


Female-Headed Households

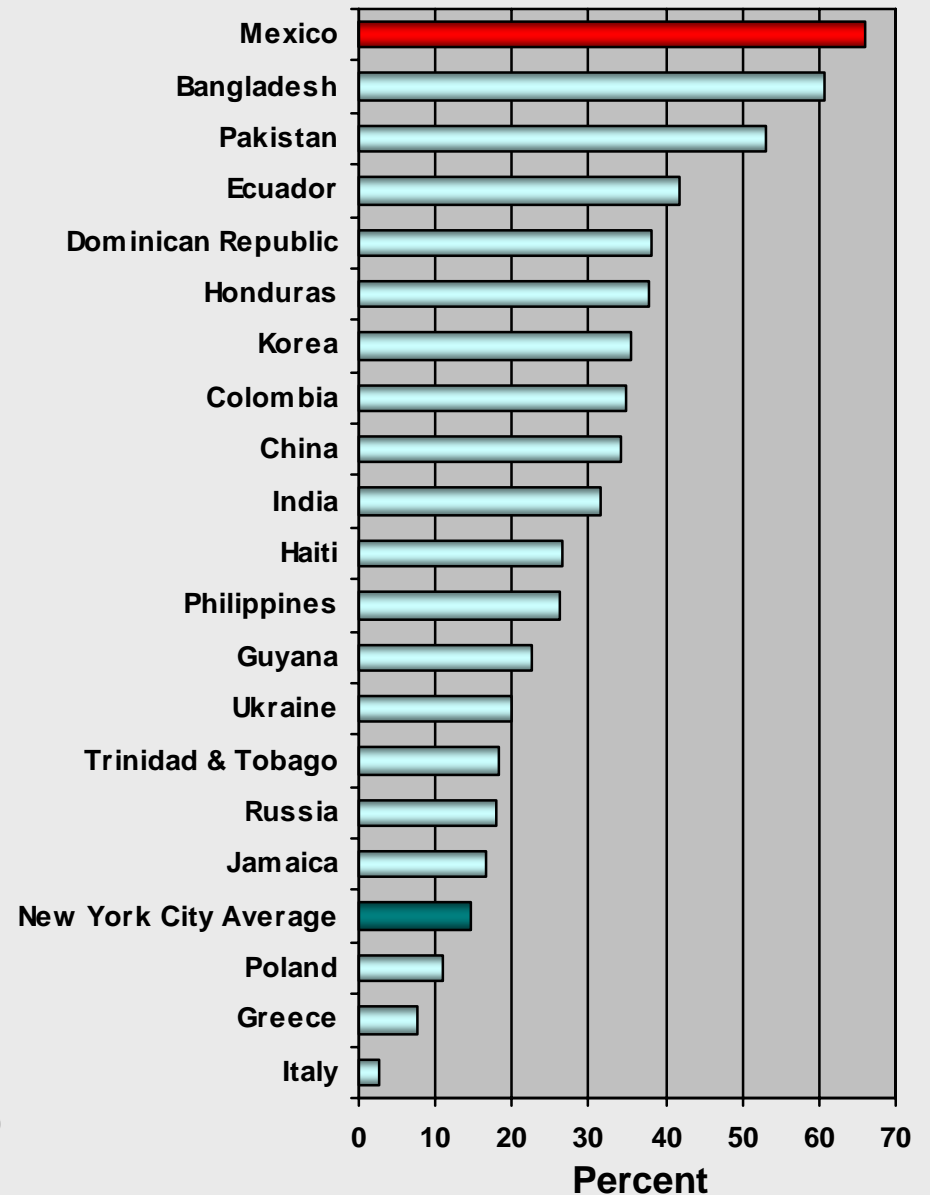

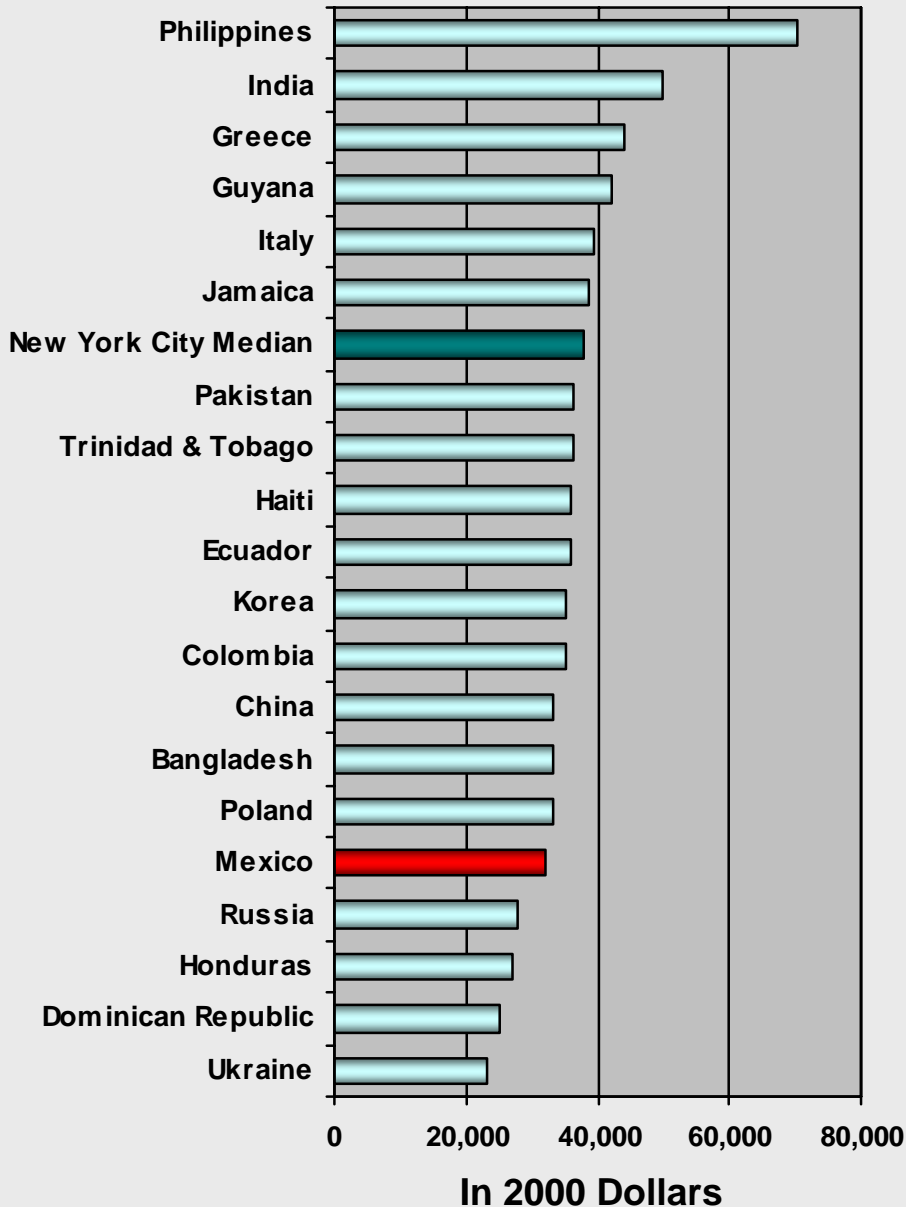


Overcrowded Households

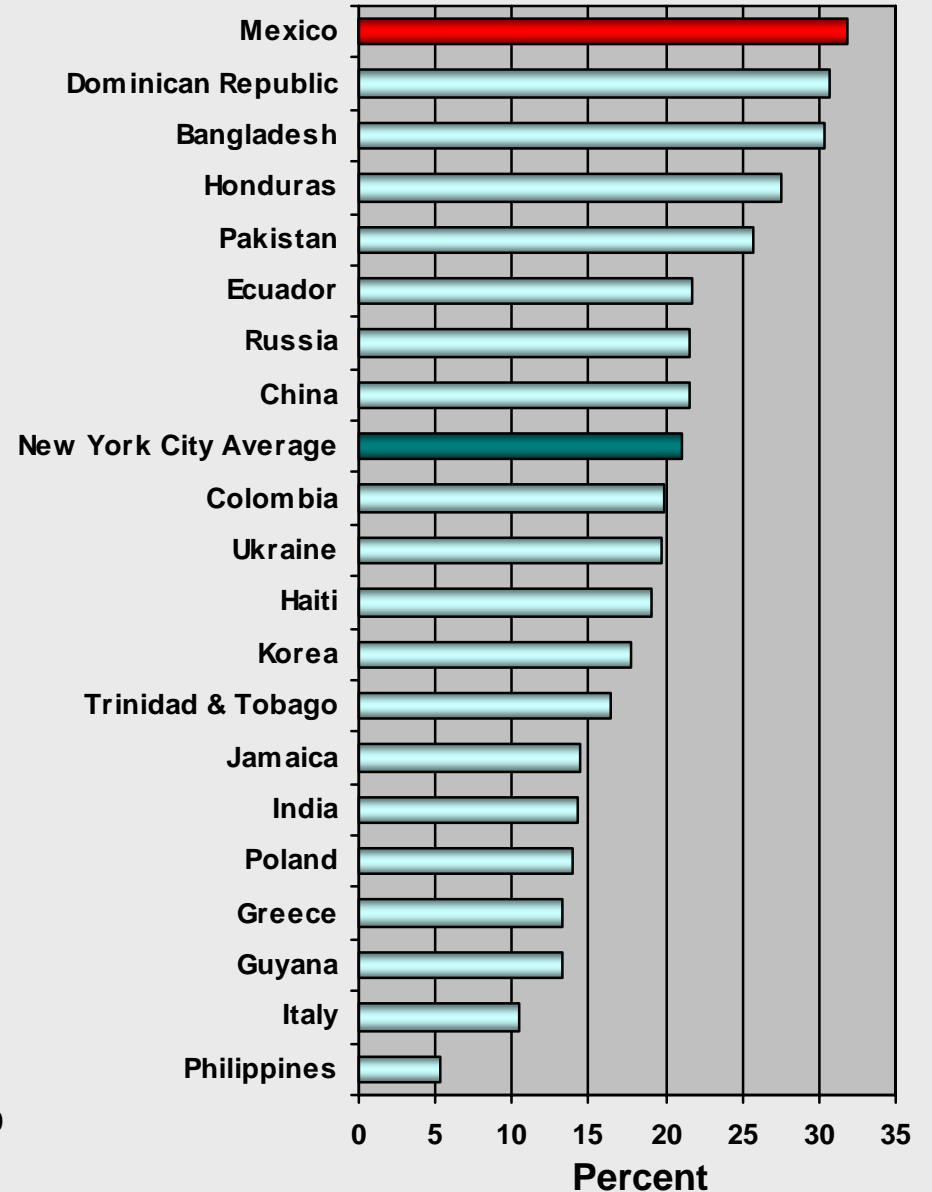

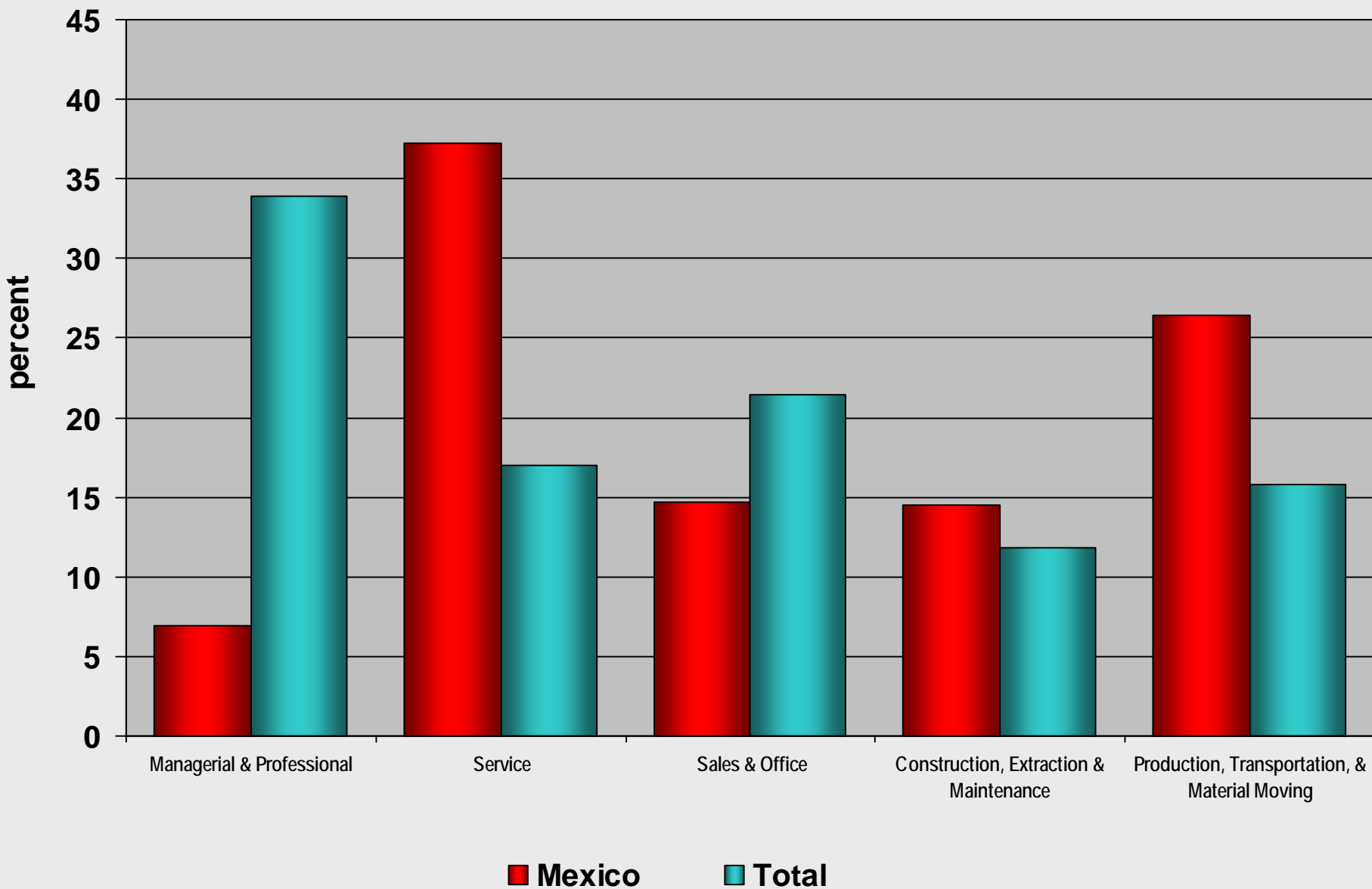

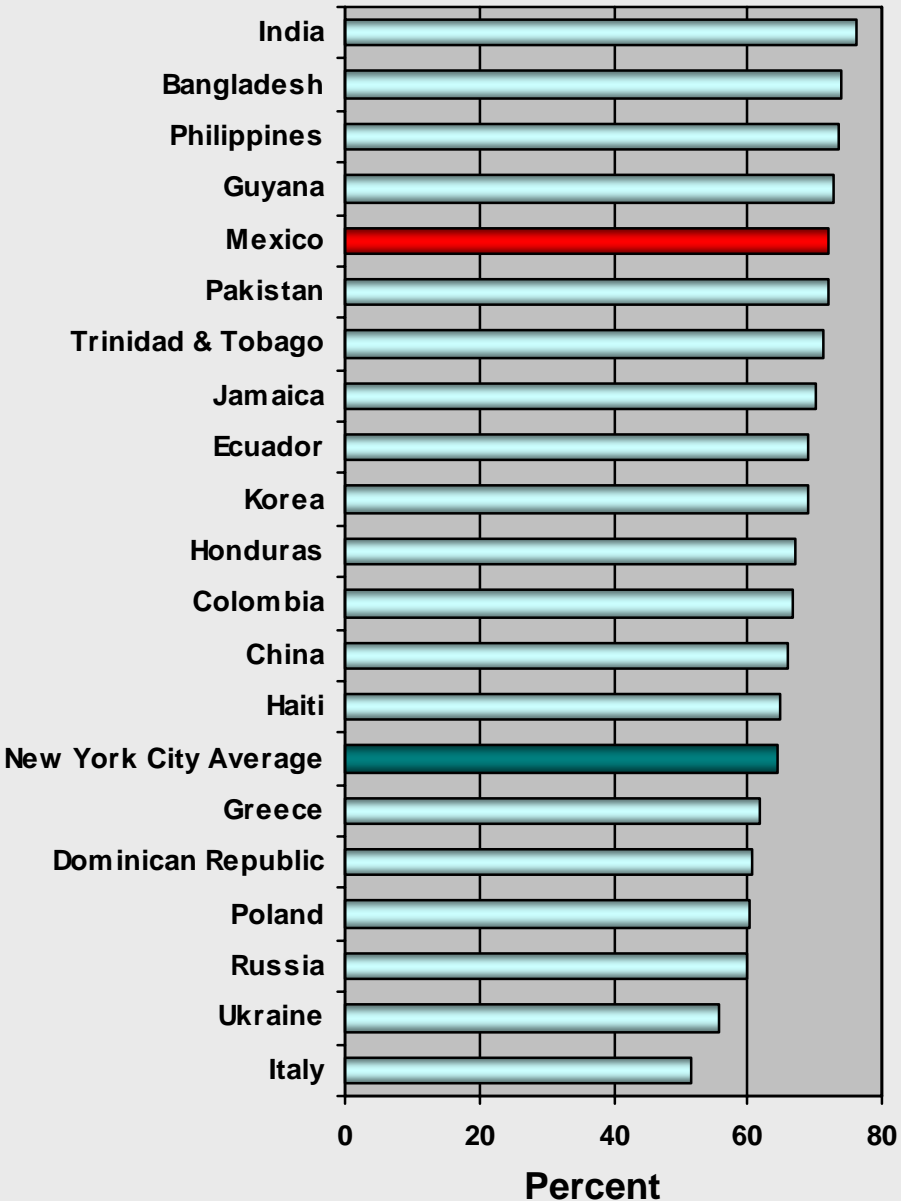


Immigrant Male Mexicans by Occupation New York City, 2000

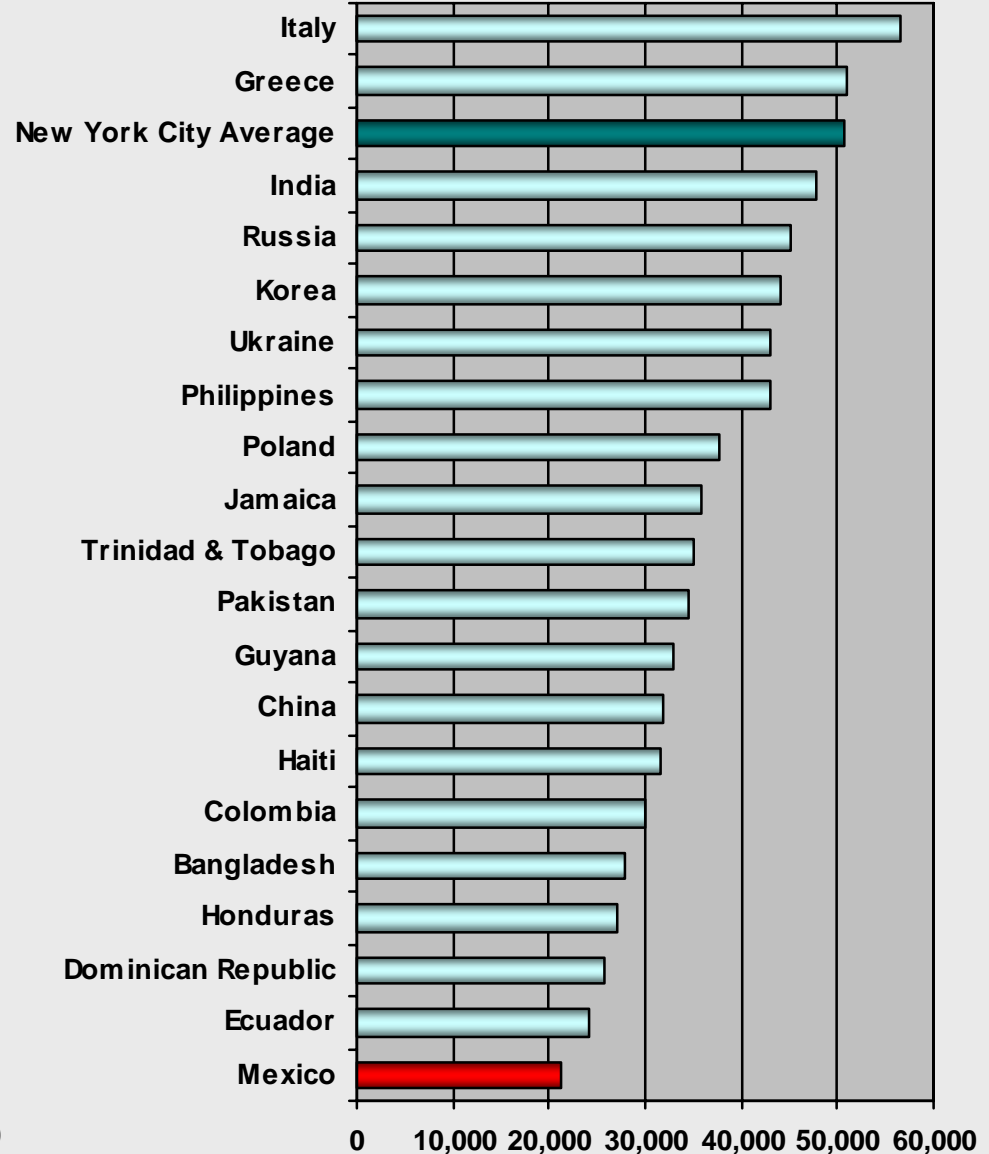


Males, Ages 16 and Over

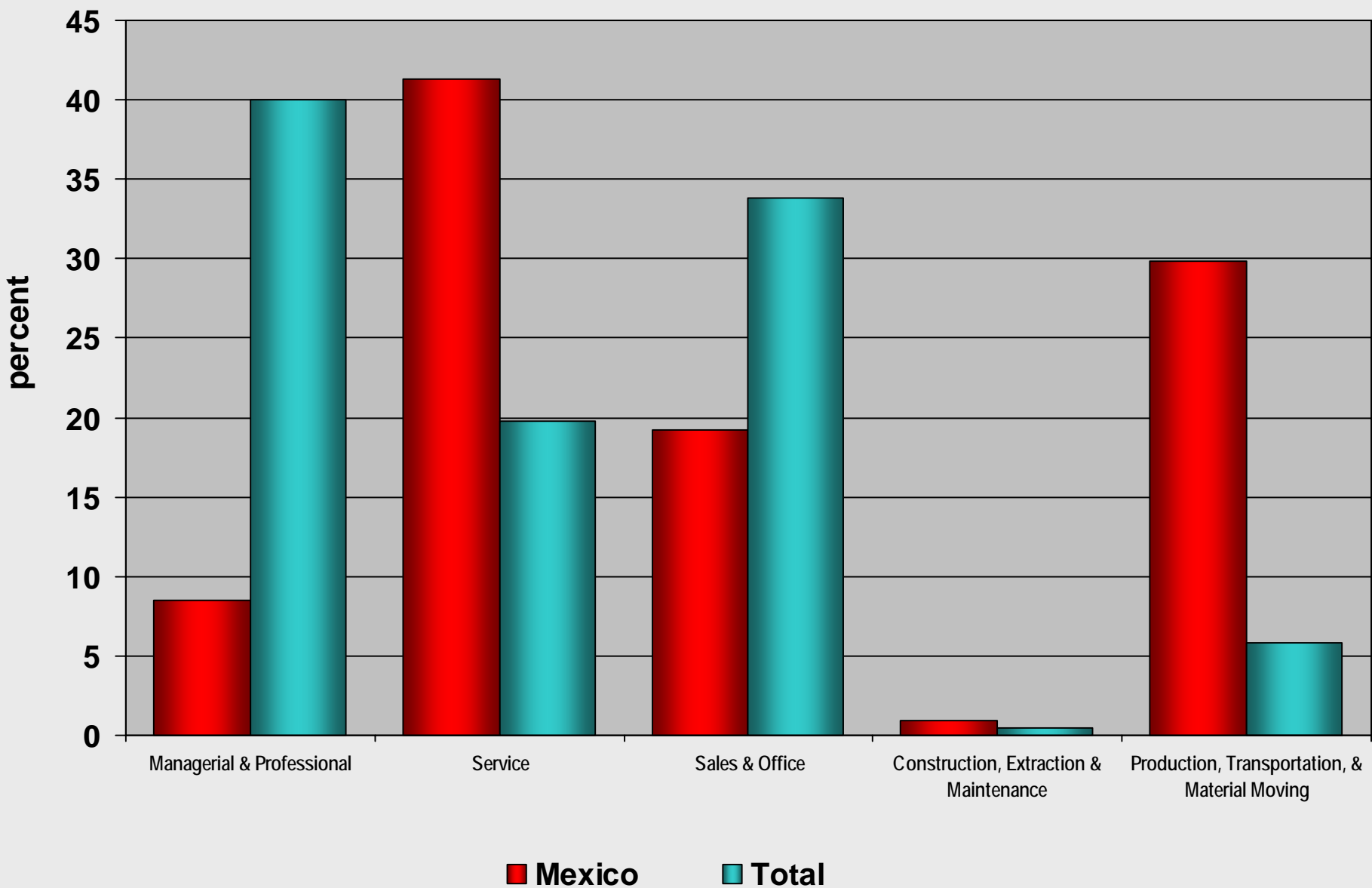
Labor Force Participation Rate



Mean Earnings (full time)

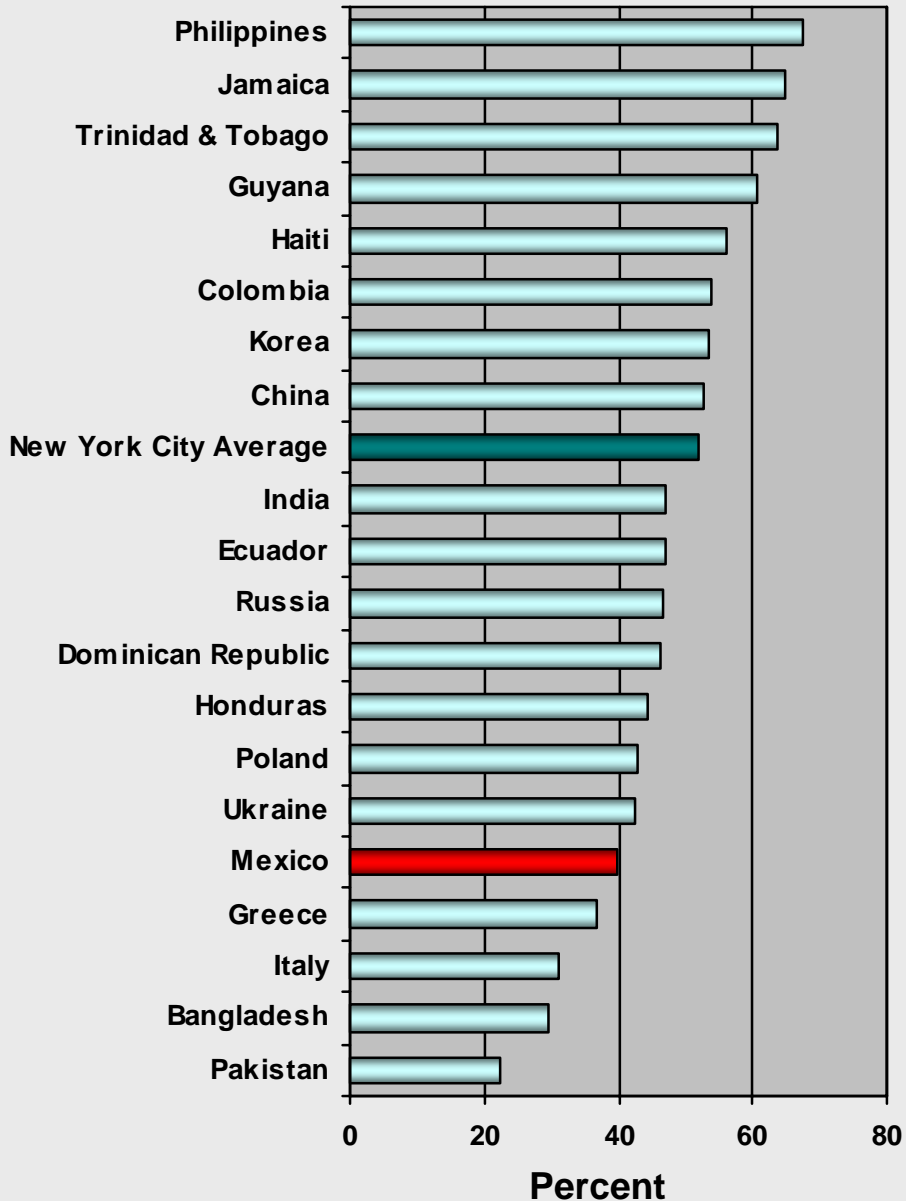


Immigrant Female Mexicans by Occupation New York City, 2000

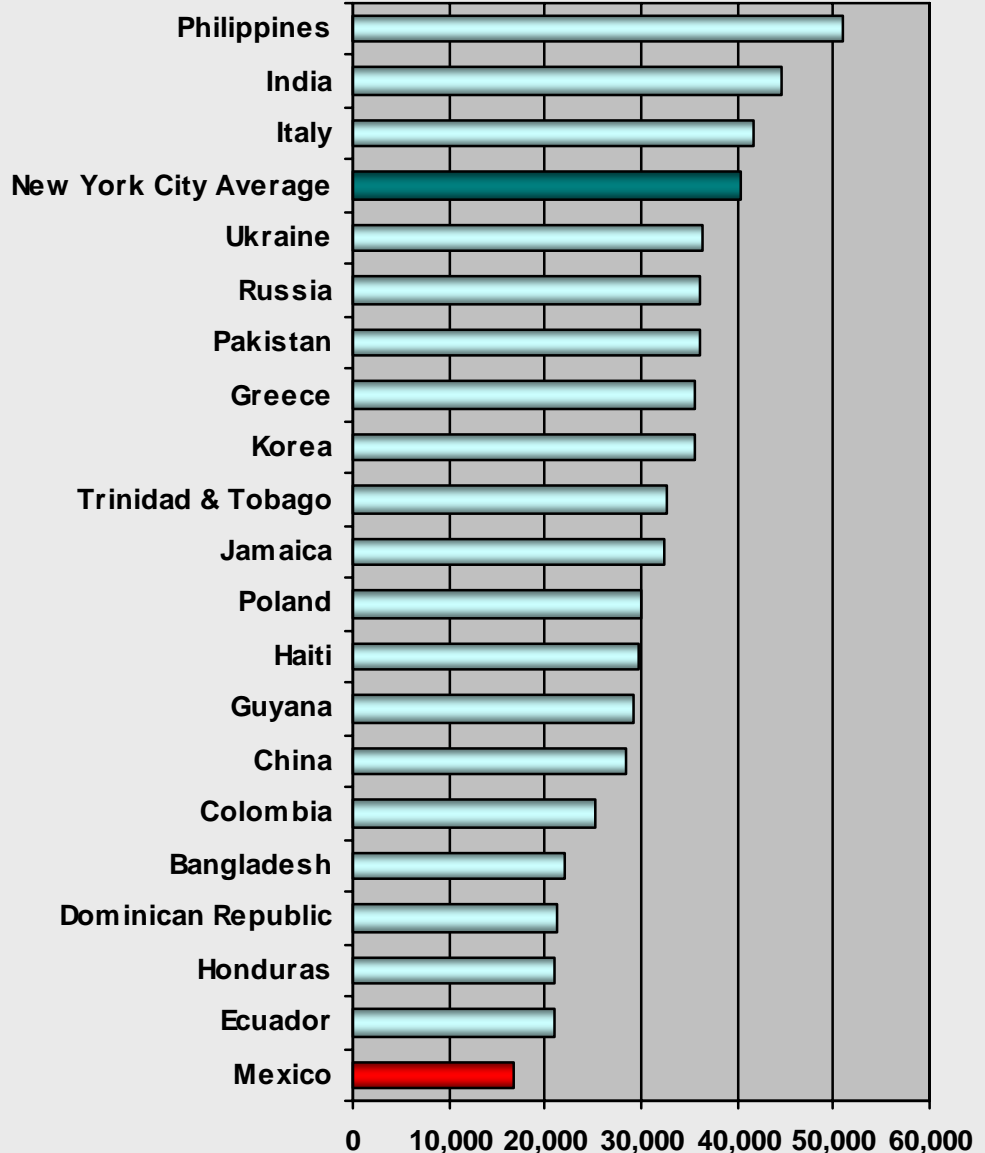


Females, Ages 16 and Over

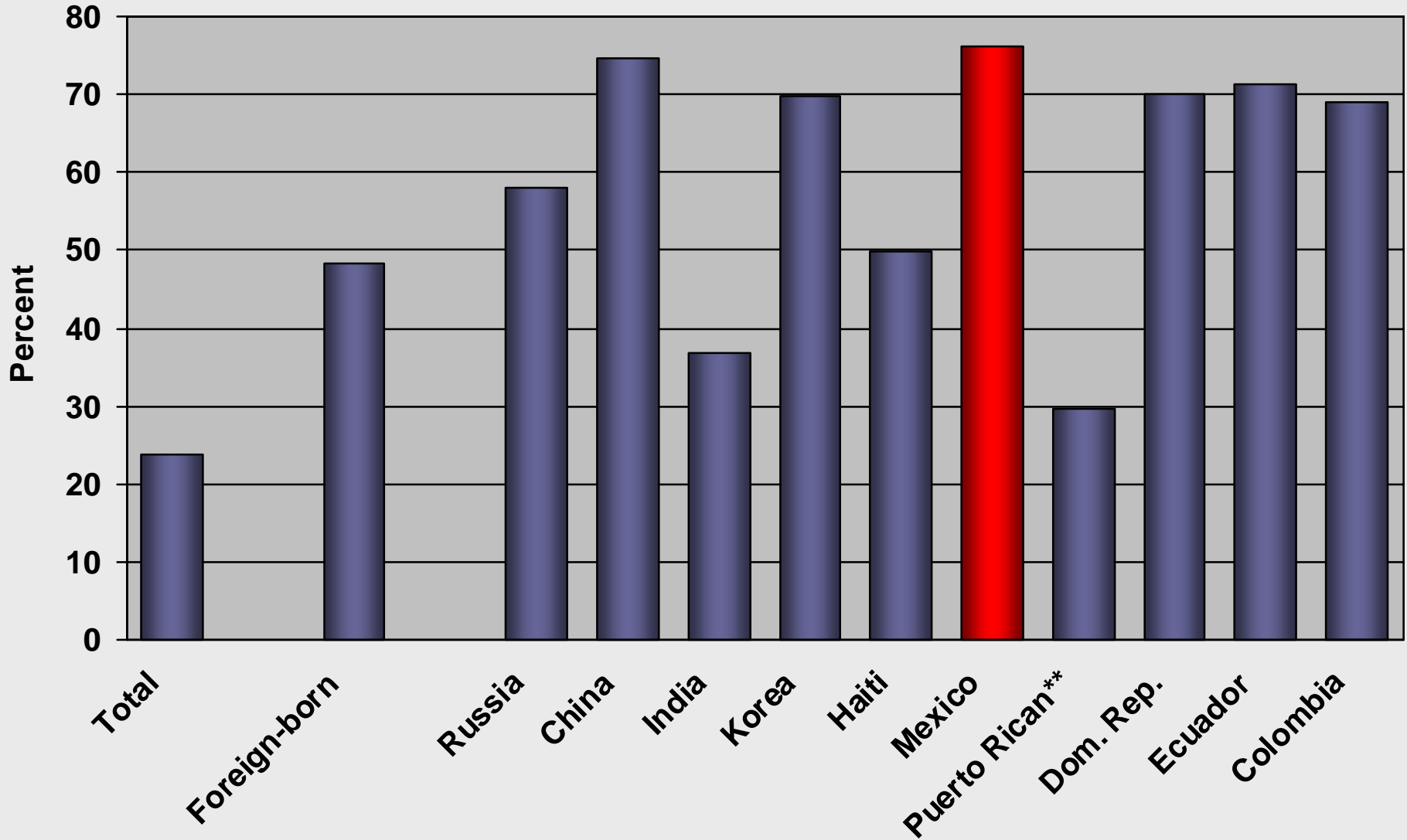

Persons not English Proficient* by Country of Birth New York City, 2000



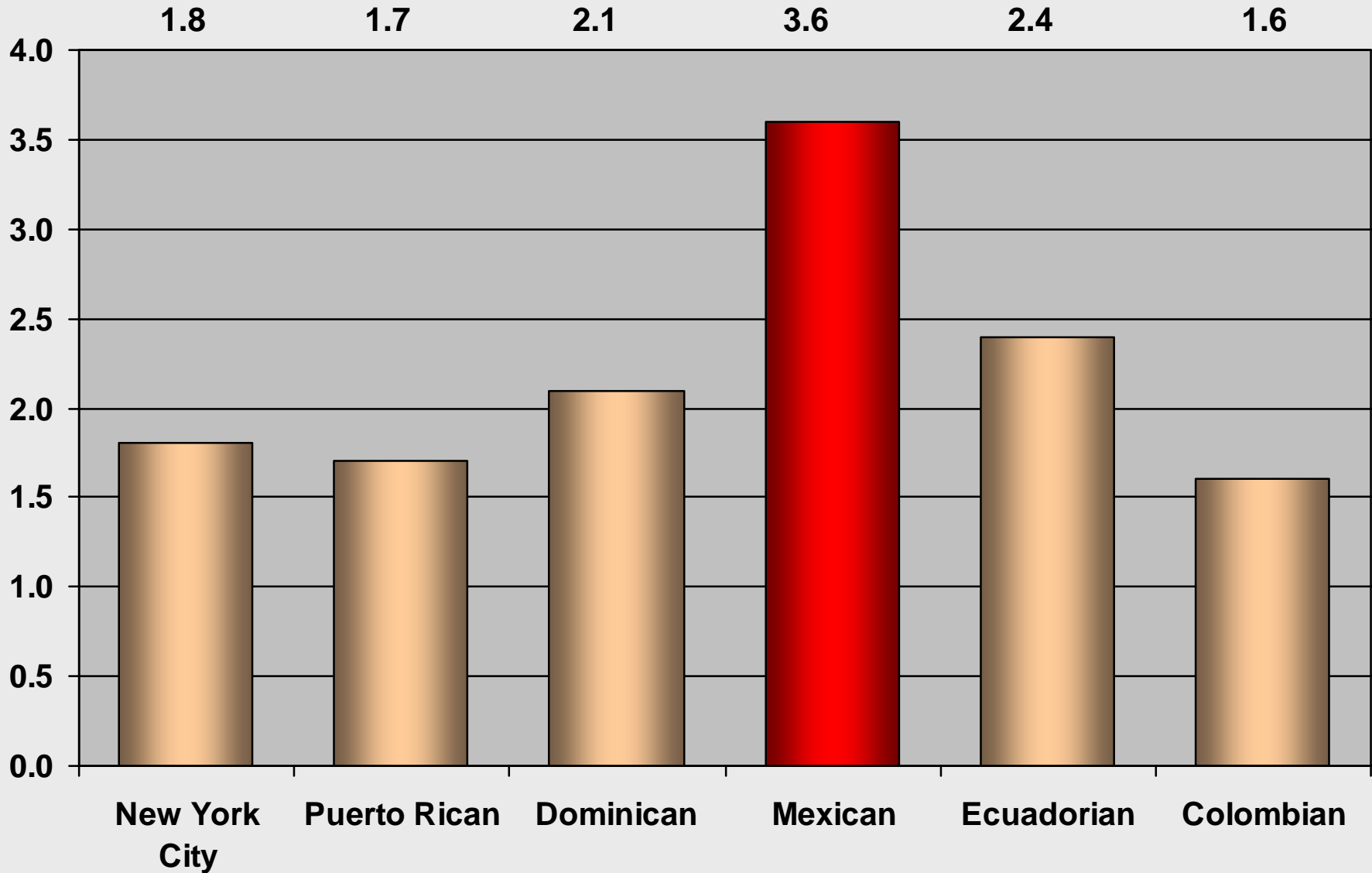

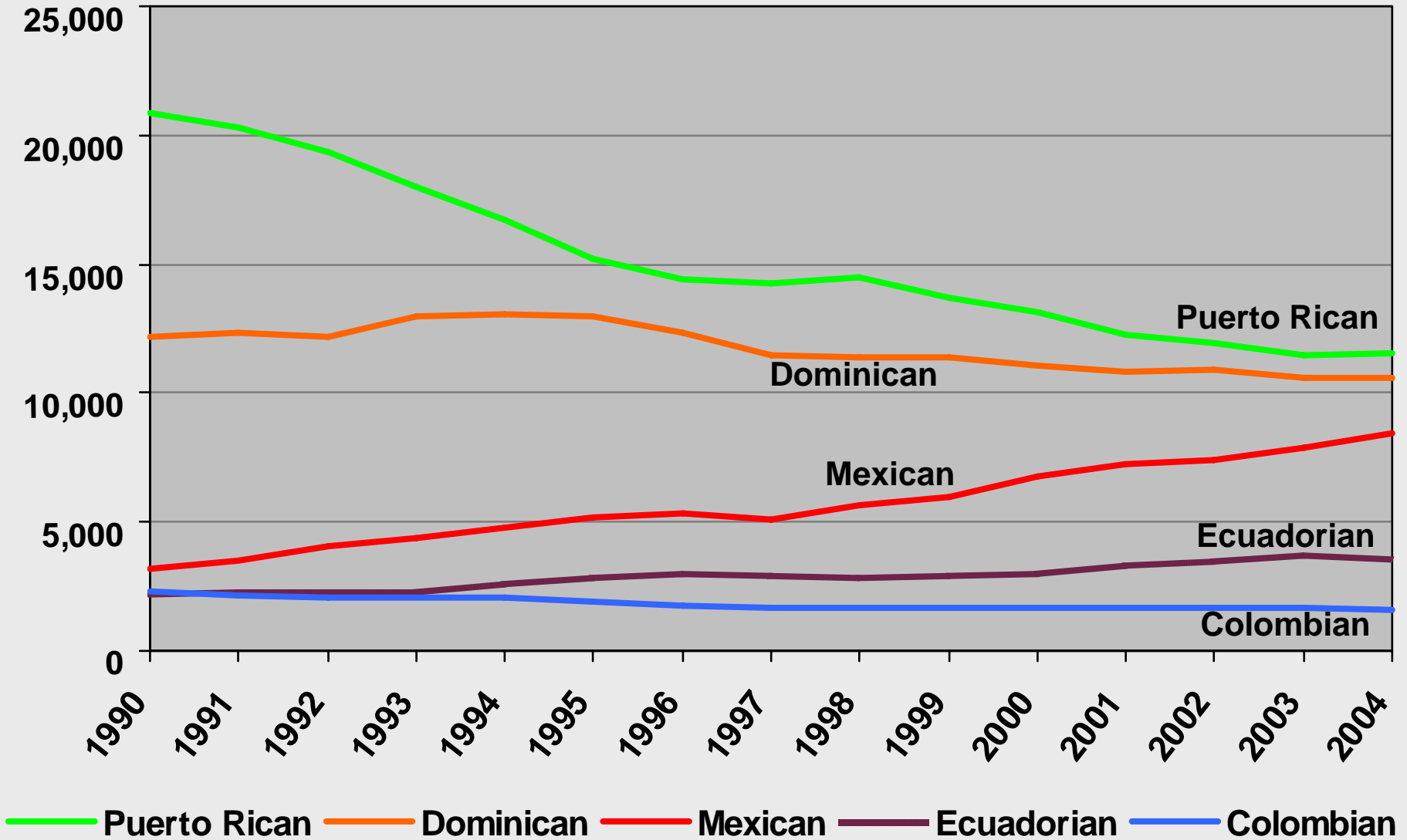

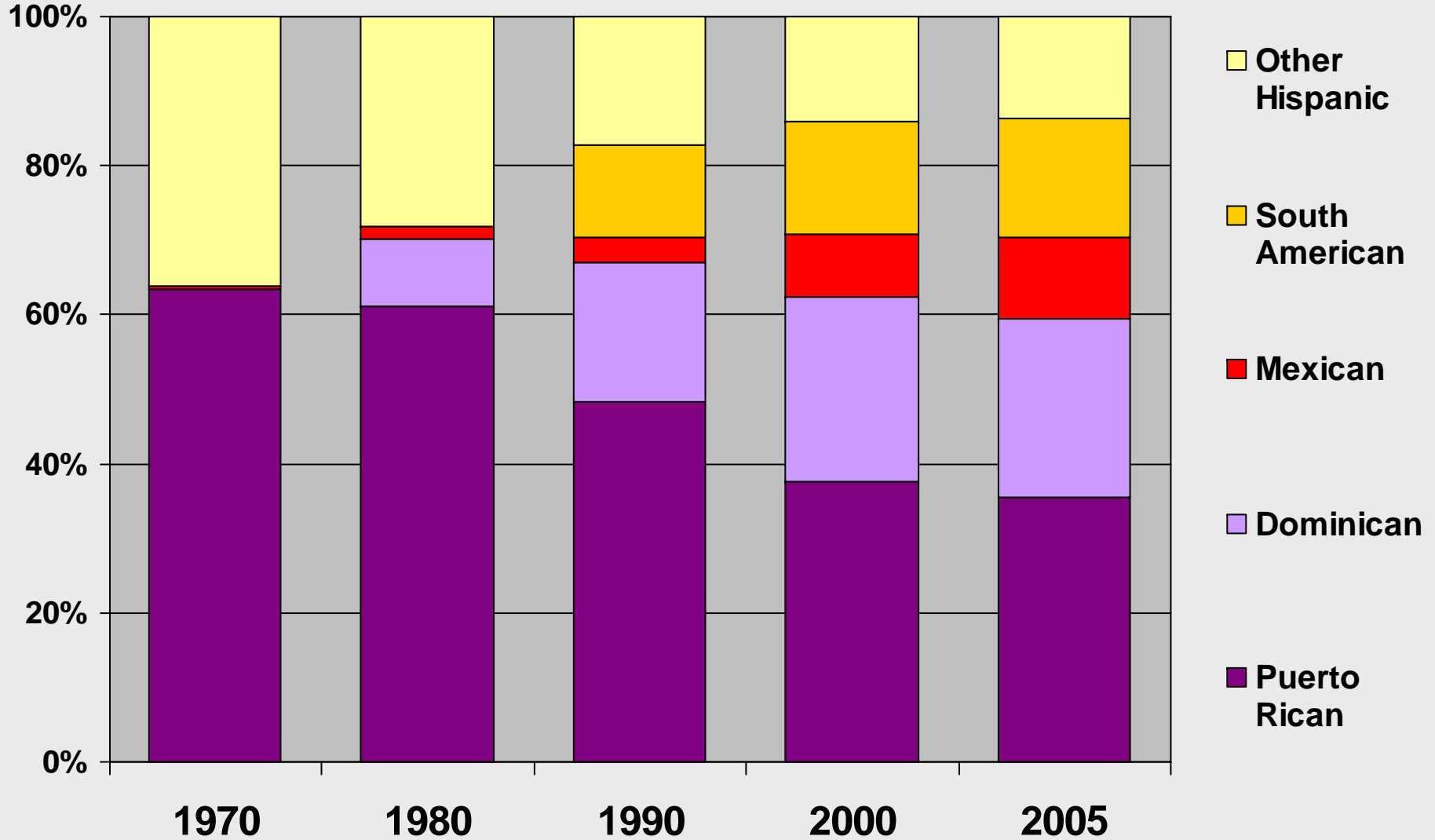

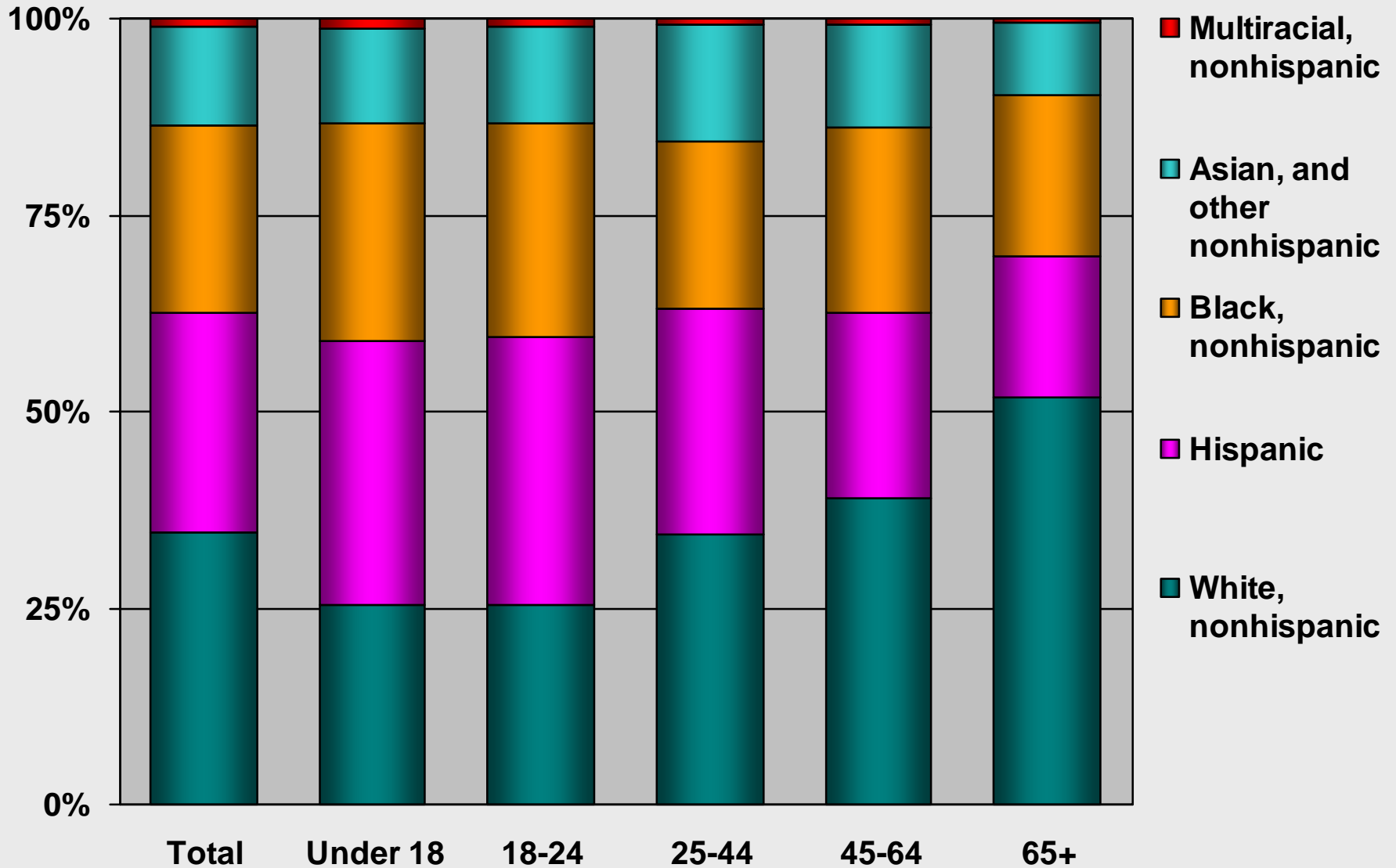
